



How to Connect to the Bonita USD Wireless



Students, Faculty & Staff who are using a personal device (non district Chromebook, iPad, laptop)

1. Users should connect to the **BUSD-BYOD** network (SSID).
2. After connecting, open a web browser and you should be directed to a login page.
 - a. Use the same username and password used to check your BUSD email or log into a BUSD computer.
3. After you successfully log in you will be directed to your computers default home page.
4. You can now begin browsing the internet.
 - a. **Note: This network will provide internet only access.**

Registered Guests who are using a personal device (non district Chromebook, iPad, laptop)

1. Users should connect to the **BUSD-Guests** network.
 - a. **Registered Guests:** Registered guests of the district will need to contact their Faculty / Staff host to receive a temporary log in and password. Only Faculty / Staff can request a guest log in from the CIS help desk (extension 8880).
2. After connecting, open a web browser and you should be directed to a login page.
3. After you successfully log in you will be directed to your computers default home page.
4. You can now begin browsing the internet.

Faculty & Staff who are using a district owned device (non district Chromebook, iPad, laptop)

District owned devices (laptops, iPads, Chromebooks) are preconfigured to connect to the **USER** network. This wireless network provides access to internal district resources and is for Faculty & Staff usage only!
