No new guidance on reclassification.</p> <p>Nancy: Preliminary allocations haven't been released. We will create a budget based on 2019-20 allocations, but the budget may have to be changed due to cuts. ConApp due date will be in August due to COVID-19-19-19.</p> <p>Title 1- Carryover percentage has been increased from 15% due to school closures.</p> <p>Title 2- can move funds to support needs due to school closures.</p> <p>Title 3- no change in regs.</p> <p>Title 4- waived 15% restriction on technology needs due to school closures.</p> <p>Nancy: ESL for summer learning will take place. Currently 45 students have registered. Will be funded with Title III. Four teachers and one supervisor.</p> <p>Matt: 2500 Chromebooks that went home (except for graduating seniors or students leaving the district) will stay at home until asked to return them.</p> <p>Imagine Learning has been widely used this year.
