7. New Business a) LCAP	Matt The LCAP explains how District monies are spent. An important expenditure will be on 8 mental health counselors. Per the WestEd survey, 40% of secondary students reported sadness or helplessness. Thus, the hiring of counselors. Another aspect of the LCAP is to report on academic progress. Test scores in Math and ELA improved and the graduation rate at 95%. Suspension rate improved by 1.5%. Chronic absenteeism is an issue and the District will engage in actions to improve it for 2019-20. Attendance went down a bit this year possibly due to weather.
