The Board discussed the options, as well as potential questions to be used for the purpose of interviewing candidates for the Board vacancy. The Board member selected their choices for potential questions and submitted them to the Superintendent for finalization.

Dr. Otto noted a scheduling conflict with the Special Board Meeting and the City of La Verne Teacher of the Year Banquet on May 24, 2006. Dr. Otto suggested the following options: 1) hold interviews earlier in the day, before the Teacher of the Year event; 2) conduct the interviews after the Teacher of the Year event; 3) move the interviews to a different day; or 4) not attend the Teacher of the Year event.
