### **AUDIT REPORTS**

The Committee is presenting to the Board of Education the performance and financial audits for the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

#### COMPLIANCE WITH CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION

Based on the performance and financial audits, the Committee finds that the Bonita Unified School District is in compliance with the requirements of Article XIII, Section 1 (b)(3) of the California Constitution. The requirements of the Article include:

- Bond proceeds have been used for the construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation or replacement of school facilities including the furnishing and equipping or school facilities.
- Bond proceeds have not been used for any other purpose including teacher and administrator salaries and other school operating expenses.
- An annual independent performance audit is conducted to ensure that bond proceeds have been expended only on specific projects.
- An annual independent financial audit is conducted until all bond proceeds have been expended.
