ADDENDUM #3

The following addendum applies to BID #18-19:09 and shall comply in accordance with the general specifications with additions or deletions stated below in Addendum #3:

- 1) I could not determine if the bid was point to point lit fiber service or metro lan lit fiber.

Metro lan lit fiber, point to multipoint is preferred, but will accept point to point proposals.

- 2) Management wants me to clarify what happens to the bid security if the proposal is not awarded.

BID SECURITY: Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check payable to the District, or a satisfactory bid bond, in favor of the District, executed by the bidder as principal and a legally admitted California surety insurer as surety, in an amount not less than \$25,000.00. The check or bid bond shall be given as guarantee that the bidder shall execute the contract if it is awarded to him in conformity with the Contract Documents and shall provide the surety bond or bonds as specified therein within five (5) days after notification of the award of the Contract, and will furnish all the required forms and documentation. It is understood and agreed that should Respondent fail or refuse to enter into the Contract Agreement and provide all documents as required by the District and the RFP, the bid security shall be forfeited to the District. If the Respondent elects to furnish a bid bond as its bid security, the Respondent shall use the bid bond form included in the RFP.

- 3) If the bidder does not have K-12 references will similar work references suffice?

Yes.

- 4) The bid requests that prices are to be provided for a 1G, each additional 1G and 10G circuits at the 8 Elementary sites. Is the 10G to be assumed as an upgrade from a 1G later in the term, after the initial 1G order is installed? Or, would the 10G be chosen as the initial order?

The bid is asking for 1gig circuits at each of the 8 Elementary sites. The 4 secondary sites get 10gig.

10G is to be assumed as an upgrade from a 1G later in the term.

- 5) One section of the RFP references service availability of 99.9% and another section states 99.5%. Can you clarify this?

99.9%

Vendor must supply 16 total addresses, in which 14 will be usable by the district; /28 CIDR.
