### BLAST PRESCHOOL

Building Lifelong Academic Skills Together (BLAST) Preschool is a language rich program for 3 and 4 year old children taught by an early childhood special education teacher with the support of two instructional paraeducators. The staff is knowledgeable on how to differentiate curriculum to fit each student's needs through hands on activities, play and positive support from staff and family. Each class consists of both children who are typical learners as well as children with special needs. The program focuses on growth in the key areas of development: cognitive, physical, language, and social-emotional. This program offers a well-rounded education that will inspire students' learning.





## PHILOSOPHY

It is the belief of Bonita Unified School District's BLAST Preschool Program that self-esteem, social skills, speech and intellectual development blossom in an inclusive environment using developmentally appropriate activities that guide students to be actively involved in exploration, discovery and play. Our preschool staff is trained in early childhood growth and development and skilled at teaching young students the skills they will need as they transition to kindergarten and beyond.
